We are currently planning on start and finish dates for 2018. I would like to invite you to let me know what you think suits you best. Essentially they are **TWO CHOICES**,


The first choice is starting the year later and finishing later. This means starting around the 7 February, maybe either side of Waitangi Day and end a few days before Christmas, maybe 22 December.
